

The ACH Child and Family Services Women's Auxiliary was originally formed in 1962 as a way for local Fort Worth women to provide support to the children living in the home through service. After 40 years, the Auxiliary was reorganized to meet the needs of a growing community, while maintaining the mission of ACH Child and Family Services. Today, members work individually with our programs to ensure growth and renewal within the organization.



## Our Purpose

The Women's Auxiliary was reinstated in 2015 during the 100-year anniversary celebration of ACH Child and Family Services. The group was tasked with a new vision to support children and families served by the organization through service opportunities and advocacy in our community.

## Recruitment

Members consist of a diverse and dynamic group of women who devote both time and resources to make a meaningful contribution. Women of all ages are welcome with the primary target being ages 30–70.
