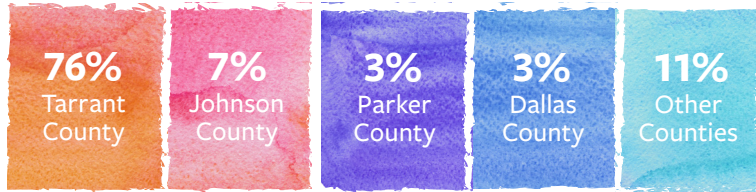

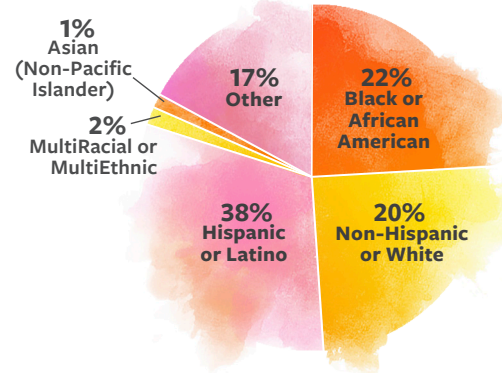
Client Snapshot

In 2023, **2,174** unduplicated clients were enrolled in ACH programs and services.

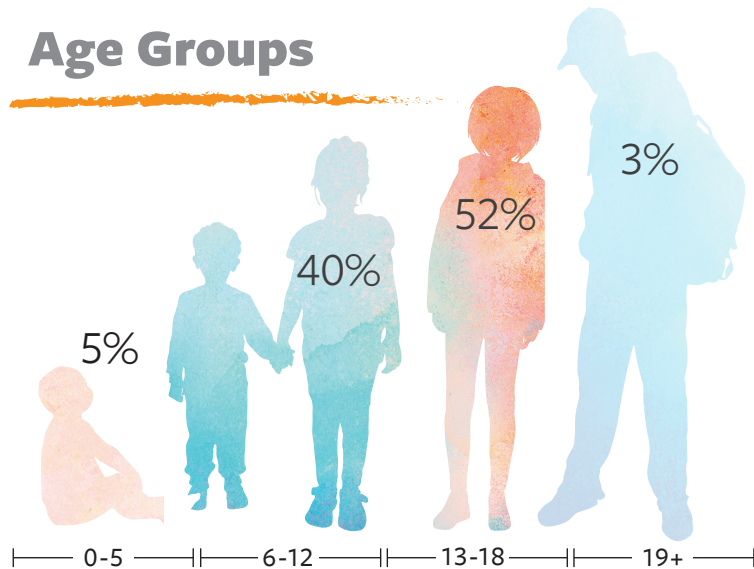
County of Origin



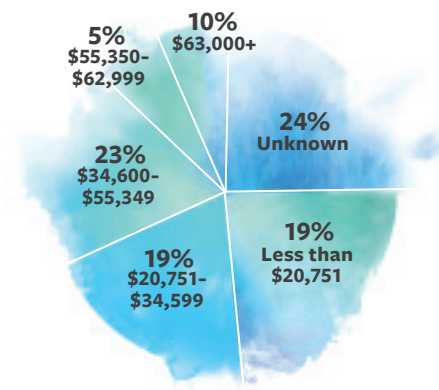
Race Ethnicity

Whenever Alex's parents were away, it was up to her to bathe, feed and clothe her five younger brothers. Once they became homeless, her mental and emotional trauma only got worse. When she was placed in foster care, she found a new home at ACH's *Wedgwood Transitional Living Program*.

To meet her therapeutic goals, the team at ACH worked with her to improve her communication skills, prioritize self-care, and to establish boundaries in her relationships. She later transferred to *The LIFE Project* and saved her money to purchase her first car, have an emergency fund, and later get her own apartment.

ACH helped prepare Alex for a successful adulthood.
